# MEMBERS' LIMITED RIGHTS PER NSS BY-LAWS 

## MEMBERS

1. Elect Directors annually at annual September meeting of members. (Art. III, Sec. 4)
2. Members do not elect Officers (President, Vice-President, etc.) (Art. IV, Sec. 4)
3. Members must be given notice of the annual meeting or any special meeting at least seven (7) days in advance.
a) Notice can be given in hand, by mail or email. (Art. III, Sec. 4)
4. Fifty per cent (50\%) of members needed for quorum at annual or special meeting of members. (Art. III, Sec. 2)
5. Members may vote at annual or special meeting by granting written proxy to another member. (Art. III, Sec. 3)
6. Members may only take official action on two (2) subjects at annual meeting of members.
a) Election of Directors (majority of vote of those in attendance). (Art. III, Sec. 3)
b) Repeal or change of By-Laws (2/3 vote of all members required). (Art. XII)
7. Members may only take official action on one (1) subject at special meeting of members. (Art. XII)
a) Repeal or change of By-Laws (2/3 vote of all members required). (Art. XII)
8. Members may bring up other matters at the annual meeting for discussion, but may not take official action, only advisory votes.
